### **OFFICE DUTIES**

Participate in our administrative offices by performing basic computer tasks, filing, etc.

### **MAIL OUTS**

Assist with our mail out efforts by stuffing and sealing envelopes for various mail projects

Help by checking and emptying food barrels at local sites and deliver food to the Food Bank
