SORTING FOOD Any food donated to the Food Bank must be sorted and categorized for distribution to agencies. WAREHOUSE ACTIVITIES

MOBILE DISTRIBUTION Assist with "drive-through" model distribution and loading boxes of food into clients' vehicles.
