The Greater Baton Rouge Food Bank is a nonprofit organization that provides services across 11 different parishes. We solicit, inventory, and distribute donated products to over 140 member agencies that directly serve people facing hard times. In 2024, the Greater Baton Rouge Food Bank distributed 12.8 million meals to those in need.


